


Phase 3 Blending to Read Parent Booklet

No printer, no problem. Just read straight from the screen. One page each day or at a pace to suit your child. Alternatively print and have as a book. Simply say the sounds, use the picture to help you remember. Point to each

sound, 'c'- 'a' -'t', then say the whole word = 'cat'. Repeat a few times randomly, not always down each column. This will keep it fun and build fluency. Challenge: Can you read super fast, by yourself?



Idea! Print the sheet, cut up the words and sort into groups j or v? Print 2 copies and play pairs, or hide and go find around the house.
